Cecil County Closures and Updates Due to Novel Coronavirus Updated for March 27, 2020, 12:30 p.m.

ELKTON, MD. – As of this morning, there are <u>12</u> confirmed cases of the Novel Coronavirus in Cecil County as reported by the Cecil County Health Department.

County Executive McCarthy will hold a press conference on Wednesday, April 1st at 3:00 p.m. via Facebook Live to present the FY2021 Budget. In order to continue to practice appropriate social distancing measures, a physical audience will not be permitted to attend.
